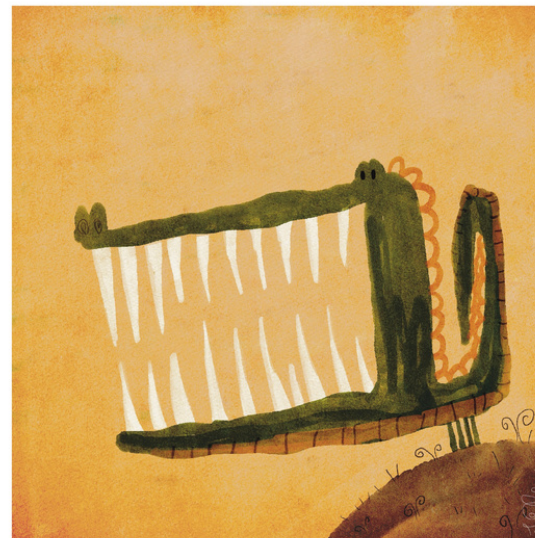


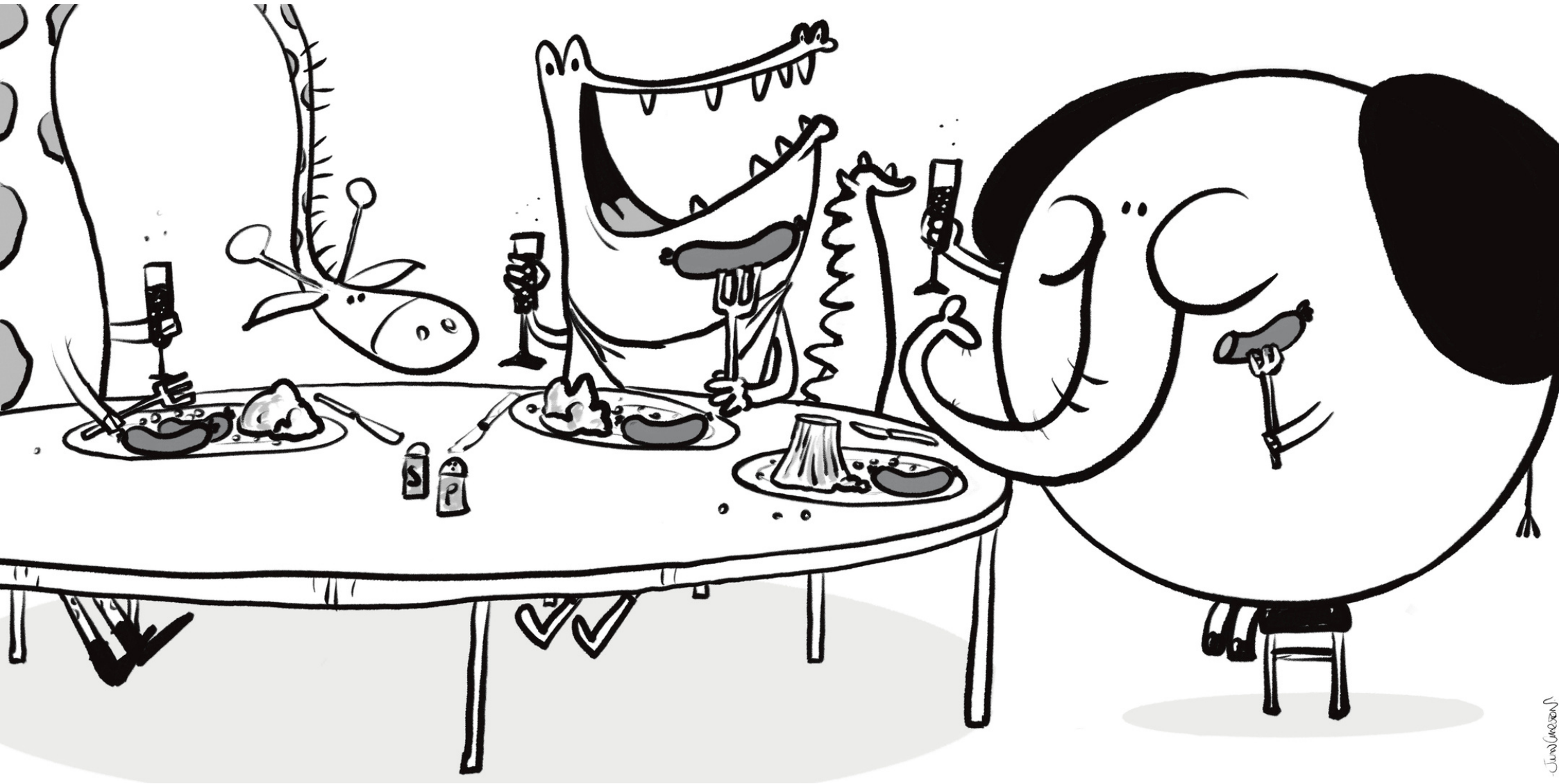












Julian Charlton
